- a) <u>Application Ref: P22/S3470/FUL</u>: 34 Blackthorn Rise Tetsworth OX9 7DZ Reconstruction of end of terrace dwelling from first floor up following extensive fire damage. Comments UNANIMOUSLY AGREED and to be submitted by the Clerk: *Tetsworth Parish Council* (TPC) *unanimously agreed their support of this application.*
- b) <u>Application Ref: P22/S3276/FUL:</u> Greenwood Cottage, 30 Silver Street Tetsworth Erection of single storey oak-framed dwelling.
   Comments UNANIMOUSLY AGREED and to be submitted by the Clerk: Tetsworth Parish Council (TPC) agreed their support of this application provided that highway specialists are satisfied with parking arrangements. Cllr. Susan Rufus did not partake following Declaration of Interest as noted.
