The census is coming

On 27 March 2011 all residential households in the United Kingdom will be taking part in a census. Since 1801 a day has been chosen every ten years for this purpose. The census provides an excellent source of information about the population. This enables central and local government, health authorities and many other organisations to plan housing, education, health and transport services for years to come.

The census statistics feed into the allocation of funding for local authorities and play a major part in their ability to provide local services, so it is crucial the population estimate is as accurate as possible. When the questionnaire envelope comes through the door you'll easily recognise it by the purple 2011 Census logo. Take care of it. If, like many people, you want to complete the questionnaire online, your individual internet code is on the front of the questionnaire.

The 2011 Census doesn't want anyone to fall behind - so there is a wide range of help options available (such as language guidance booklets, large print format, Text

Legal record of public rights of way goes online

Oxfordshire County Council's Countryside Service has published online the legal record of public rights of way across the county.

The 'Definitive Map and Statement' will enable home and land buyers to check whether public routes cross a property, as well as providing a resource for anyone considering applying to change the route of a path.

Previously available only as a paper copy, the map shows the exact location of public rights of way including public footpaths, bridleways, restricted byways and byways.

The 'Definitive Statement' gives a description of each public right of way, including any limitations or conditions such as the width of path. The record reveals a total length of over 2,600 miles of public rights of way throughout Oxfordshire.

Paper copies

Paper copies of the Definitive Map and Statement are still available for inspection as previously at the Countryside Service office, Oxfordshire Studies and certain local libraries and district council offices.

Rodney Rose, Oxfordshire County Council's Cabinet Member for Transport, said: "We are delighted that the Definitive Map and Statement has become much more readily available to the public through its publication on our website. As well as facilitating access to this record, the online

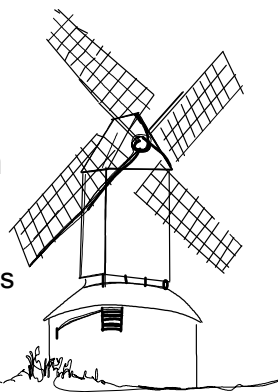

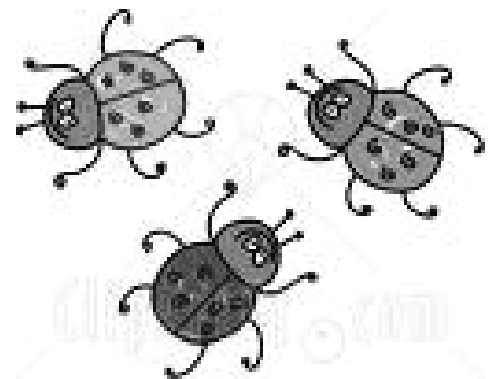
