Exciting opportunity to be involved in new police accountability arrangements

On 15 November 2012, the Thames Valley will be electing its first Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) who will be responsible for setting the priorities and resources for Thames Valley Police, as well as supporting broader community safety activities across the region.

Alongside this a Police and Crime Panel will also be established to scrutinise the work of the PCC. The purpose of this role is to assist the PCC through providing independent challenge as a critical friend.

The panel will be made up of one representative from each of the 18 local authorities in the force area, and two independent co-opted members.

The panel is looking for two committed and energetic people who either live or work within the Thames Valley to serve as co-opted independent members from Autumn 2012 for a four-year term. This is an exciting opportunity to be involved from the start of new and very different arrangements for reducing crime and disorder.

This is an important and high profile role. It is expected that this the time commitment would be approximately one day a month, including preparation and travel time.



- Romanian Folk Dances is an exuberant piece by the Hungarian Béla Bartók and is a product of his folksong collecting expeditions in Romania. Bartók's music soon moved away from the folk tradition in to an atonal, twelvenote style which influenced many composers, including the Polish Witold Lutoslawski.
- Lutoslawski wrote the Musique Funebre, à la memoire de Béla Bartók, to commemorate the tenth anniversary of Bartók's death. This piece introduced his own brand of twelve-note music, marking his departure from the explicit use of folk music

Think you may have been mis-sold payment protection insurance?

If the company who sold you payment protection knew it was wrong for you, or didn't check on your circumstances properly before selling it to you, (for example, the policy doesn't cover self-employed people and you're self-employed), you may be able to make a claim for misselling.

This means that the company has sold you a policy when they shouldn't have done, and you may be able to cancel the policy and get a refund. If you think you've been missold PPI for any reason, you can make a complaint to the company that sold you the policy.

If you don't get anywhere with the company which sold you the policy, you may need to refer your complaint to the Financial Ombudsman Service. You should use the complaint form on their website at: www.financialombudsman.org.uk.

The major banks have written to customers they believe 7.30 pm may have been mis-sold PPI. If you have received a letter, Wednesday it will explain the steps you need to take next.

Finally, beware of companies offering to help you with a Thursday **claim** – many such offers are a front for a scam designed to get you to hand over bank card details or shell out money you will never see again. Others do offer a service but this can be very expensive and can eat up all the compensation you get, or even leave you in debt. Some cold call or send text messages out of the blue – these are best ignored Monday 25th June and deleted.
