County council grant gives a boost to local wood fuel project

A scheme aimed at helping more people to use local renewable fuel and improve the management of local woodlands has received a cash boost from Oxfordshire County Council.

The Trust for Oxfordshire's Environment (TOE2) Community Woodfuel Programme has been given £25,000 by the county council to boost its initiative to increase the supply and demand for local woodfuel, connect local residents

with their local energy supply and in doing so improve biodiversity and reduce 'fuel miles'.

The initiative was set up in October 2012 with initial funding from the Esmee Fairbairn Foundation and the Forestry Commission. Oxfordshire County Council's money will enable TOE2 to extend the programme and to run a series of public and community events, establish an Oxfordshire quality standard for firewood, develop directories of woodfuel suppliers and wood stove suppliers for Oxfordshire, run study visits, and roll out a 'logs for labour' scheme that matches woodland owners with local residents who are willing to manage the woodlands in return for logs.

The first six months of the programme have already seen several successful 'logs for labour' events, community bulletins, training and information events, a draft firewood quality standard, and development of a website, www.oxonwoodfuel.org.uk



a fuel helps to reduce carbon dioxide and greenhouse gas emissions. Although burning wood emits carbon dioxide, trees absorb carbon dioxide while they are growing so wood is almost 'carbon neutral'.

"Felling and coppicing trees replaces a shady habitat with a more open habitat, allowing plants and animals to thrive that would otherwise be shaded out. It maintains a historic landscape, preserves local skills, and promotes physical fitness and mental health.

"Local wood suppliers will also benefit from better business. By signing up to the OxLogs standard being developed by TOE2, they can guarantee that they are supplying high quality logs and customers will be better informed.

"I would encourage Oxfordshire residents to look at the website and sample from the wide range of information and events available through the programme."

Karen Woolley, chairman of TOE2 said: "Our Woodfuel Programme has been incredibly popular with local communities. This grant from Oxfordshire County Council means that we can extend the programme and encourage more local people to keep their homes warm with logs from local woodlands.

Martin Tugwell, Deputy Director (Strategy and Infrastructure Planning), Oxfordshire County Council, said: "I'm very pleased that the county council can support the Woodfuel Programme. It's great to be able to support their work with local communities and businesses that will increase the use of locally sourced timber and reduce dependence on fossil fuels. Not only is this great for the Oxfordshire environment, it's good for the local economy."


