Tetsworth Primary School – Small School Big Ideas!

Tetsworth Primary School may be a small village school but it has always had BIG IDEAS. On Thursday 7th April 2011 the children performed "Joseph and his Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat" to family, staff and member of the local community.

The show was a modern take on a traditional story with no less than 3 Joseph wannabees, all competing in an X-Factor style talent competition!

The children wrote scripts, made props and costumes, including Anubis; a jackal headed Egyptian God, who stands taller than most of the cast, prepared video interviews that were broadcast throughout the performance and worked the lighting desk.

The idea for the show came about when staff were planning Class 2's topic; the Ancient Egyptians, linking the production to different curriculum areas including PowerPoint and video production in ITC, props, poster and ticket design in Art and script writing in literacy as well as drama!

We were also thrilled to debut our new lighting equipment (courtesy of TPSA funds) which has enabled the children to learn yet another theatrical skill, and has proved a valuable outlet for those children that are happier backstage rather than front of house.

The children of Class 2 also thoroughly enjoyed their trip to Pitt Rivers museum at the end of last term which helped to embed the work they have been doing on the Egyptians.

The school also has great plans to celebrate the Royal Wedding including learning flower arranging, making bunting and wedding favours, designing wedding dresses, looking at family trees, together with a 'posh' MUFTI day with a Royal picnic lunch, and a mock wedding acted out in the church! It promises to be a great celebration all round!

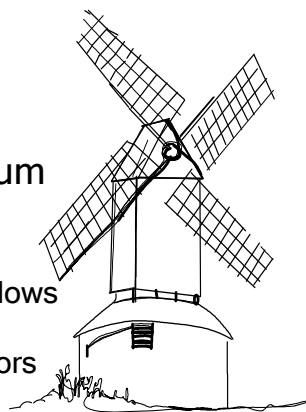
